CONDITIONS

If you accept an offer of an award from EDAC, this signifies that you agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

- The Grant Award may only be used for the purposes stated in your application and as confirmed in the Award letter.
- That you agree to submit the completed Grant Report Form within two months of the completion of the project or event.
- Should you not use the Grant Award due, for example to illness or cancellation of a course, the Award must be returned to EDAC.

THE FORM

Part 1: Eligibility

EDAC can make small grants to individuals, typically to support attendance at courses or towards costs of arts projects of a high standard. **There is no age limit.**

Part 4: Course or Project

Please give as much detail as you can of what you want the grant for.

Part 5: Financial information

Provide details and costs of all expenditure related to the course or project for which the grant is required.

List any other grants that you have applied for, the amount requested and the amount already granted. " If no other grants have been applied for please state "NONE". If no decision has been received please state "AWAITED".

State the amount of Grant required. (The maximum that the Arts Council can award to individuals is £100).

Part 6: Bank information

This must be completed.
